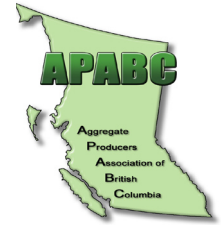


Construction Aggregate Workplace Safety workshop



Learn to identify pit or quarry hazards specific to your site, and implement a checklist of good practices to improve safety and utility in your operations!

The Workshop

This 5 hour workshop is designed to identify operational risks, establish skills-based safety standards and provide employers with a flexible toolset to mitigate risks based on their own mine-specific operational requirements.

The Construction Aggregate Workplace Safety workshop was developed by the Construction Safety Network (CSN) on behalf of the Aggregate Producers Association of British Columbia (APABC) who worked in partnership with the BC Ministry of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources (MEMPR).

Why Sign Up?

You will learn to identify and assess pit or quarry hazards specific to your operation, and implement corrective actions to improve safety and utility in your operations.

The workshop will provide participants with tools to create their own Risk Management System and provides them with a toolbox talk organizer for their sites. Workshop participants will also receive access to the online webtool which houses a database of printable risk profiles for virtually every job in a pit, listing common hazards and providing a checklist of good practices.

After taking the workshop CSN Safety Advisors will also be available to help you develop your own site-specific risk management system that you may use to apply for a Construction Aggregate Safety Leader (CASL) certificate.
